New & Updated Features

Internal Syndication Export on React

The Internal Syndication Export interface has been fully migrated to React, providing improved performance, responsiveness, and user experience.

Section Editing for Nearly All Objects

You can now edit sections across almost all object types in EMMS, streamlining content updates and management.

EPG API for VLC and VLE

A new Electronic Program Guide (EPG) API is now available for VLC and VLE. While it is not yet integrated with any front-end interfaces, this enhancement lays the groundwork for future schedule-driven features.

Ad Slot Support for VLC/VLE Schedules

Ad slot capabilities are now supported in VLC and VLE schedules. This feature is currently inactive while we await additional updates from our development team.

Improved API Validation

New safeguards are in place to prevent overlapping events in VLC and VLE schedules, ensuring cleaner programming timelines.

Platform Enhancements

Streamlined Media Deletion with Syndication Access Key Removal

When an internal syndication access key is deleted, all associated media in the ingesting account will now be automatically removed, simplifying content lifecycle management.

Bug Fixes & Stability Improvements

A variety of minor issues have been addressed to improve overall system performance, stability, and reliability.
